There are too many craft beverage stops on the Lake Erie Shores & Islands Cheers Trail to complete in just one day. So, please take your time and enjoy them responsibly. Our trail is self-guiding and does not have to be completed all in the same day. The legal drinking age in Ohio is 21, so you must be at least 21 to participate in the Cheers Trail. If you decide to visit several locations in one day, designate a driver or utilize a hired driving service.

When you make the decision to purchase a locally-made, craft beverage, you are choosing to support the local economy. Each maker on the Cheers Trail is a small business located in the Lake Erie Shores & Islands region. As with any small business, these beverage makers are essential to the local economy. They support local employment and bring people to the region to explore everything it has to offer. Cheers!!
